SUBJECT: Port of Nogales Sunday Service for 2016

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Port of Nogales, Commercial Facility will begin offering Sunday services beginning February 7, 2016. Sunday hours of operation will be 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. for both north and south bound commercial traffic. No Sunday services will be offered on Easter Sunday, March 27th.

This bulletin only applies to commercial truck processing and will not impact existing hours of service at the port such as Rail Operations or Passenger Processing.

CBP will assess the demand for such service every 30 days. If CBP determines that the traffic does not justify the increased service, CBP will issue a trade bulletin notifying the end of the pilot and give the trade two weeks advance notice.
