

Mexico Shipping Point Trends

September 17, 2024

Unless otherwise stated, shipments, crossings or imports are for the weeks ending August 31 and September 7 and 14, 2024, in that order in thousand hundredweight (cwt) or 100,000-pound units. The expected movement is for the period September 15-28, 2024. Prices are for Monday September 16, 2024, compared to Monday September 9, 2024. Unless otherwise stated, sales are F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis (including Delivered Sales, F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis) or port of entry, and extra services are included. Prices represent open (spot) market sales by first handlers on products of generally good quality and condition unless otherwise stated and may include promotional allowances or other incentives. No consideration is given to after-sale adjustments unless otherwise stated. Brokerage fees paid by the shipper are included in the price reported.
